Caring properly for fabrics, wood, and other materials helps preserve the beauty and durability of your furniture for years to come. Here's some simple guidelines on how to do it right.

FABRIC Care Guide

STAIN REMOVAL:

If you act quickly, it is not difficult to remove spills and prevent stains from forming. However, we cannot guarantee complete stain removal.

First, scrape off any liquids or hardened residues with a spoon or a scoop before you proceed. Any loose particles must be vacuum cleaned before further cleaning. Liquids must be soaked up with an absorbent napkin or cloth.

Remove non-greasy stains by carefully dabbing with a lint-free cloth or sponge wrung out in warm water. Edge marks can be avoided by dabbing gently in circular motions towards the centre of the stain with a clean lint-free cloth. Remove greasy stains by using appropriate detergents or solvents. In all cases, we recommend to test stain-removal agents on an inconspicuous area first, to see if there is any effect on the cover.

Make sure to dry the fabric fully before use. It may also be necessary to use a hairdryer to avoid leaving edge marks. This applies especially to microfibre textiles.

These tips are purely recommendations and cannot guarantee complete stain removal. In all cases, we recommend contacting a professional dry cleaning. In order to ensure satisfactory results, particularly for large stains, we recommend to contact a professional

REMOVABLE COVERS:

Removable covers made from Trevira CS can be machine washed at maximum 40/60°C. Moreover, it is possible to wash certain cotton fabrics and micro-fibre textiles. Removable covers made from wool cannot be washed but should be dry cleaned.

Use washing detergent designated for coloured textiles and obey the dosage. Wash the fabric inside-out and load only half on the machine. Spin-dry the fabric with decreased speed. The covers should be dried while suspended and mounted or applied while still slightly damp in order to ease the process.

Not all covers with zippers are designed to be removable. Please ask the furniture manufacturer. We recommend contacting a professional dry cleaner for especially huge covers.

CLEANING:

VACUUM CLEAN FREQUENTLY, IDEALLY EVERY WEEK. REMOVE STAINS AS SOON AS THEY OCCUR, WITH CLEAN WARM WATER OR SPARKLING WATER.

EXTRACTION CLEAN WHEN NECESSARY. EXTRACTION CLEANING MIGHT DISSOLVE WATER BASED GLUE.

PAY ATTENTION TO TEMPERATURE AND AMOUNT OF CLEANING FLUID.

OAK After Care Guide



DUST Use a soft, lint-free cloth (cotton or microfiber) to wipe away dust. Dust can be abrasive,

WIPE SPILLS Oil finishes are not as waterproof as polyurethane. If you spill liquid, blot it up immediately with a clean cloth. Do not let water sit on the surface, as it can raise the grain or leave white rings.

WIPE SPILLS **SURFACE** - only affecting **MINOR** - penetrating the **DEEP** - requiring wood



THINGS **SILICON-BASED POLISHES:**
Silicon-based Polishes: Avoid aerosol sprays like Pledge. They create a barrier that prevents the wood from accepting new oil later and can leave a hazy film.

DIRECT HEAT AND SUNLIGHT:
Prolonged exposure to direct sunlight can fade the wood and dry out the oil finish. Use coasters for hot drinks to prevent heat rings.

HARSH CHEMICALS:
Never use bleach, ammonia, or abrasive cleaners, as they will strip the oil and damage the wood fibers.
